A) Weatherford argues that Columbus' credit for the discovery of America is a falsehood and that he is responsible for genocide in the Americas. Native Americans were already inhabitants of Columbus' new world at the time of his discovery. The clear establishment of civilizations in the New World by the Natives illustrates that Columbus has been unfairly credited with the discovery.

B) Flynn states that despite the negative judgments toward Columbus, he is undeniably influential to the success of the modern world. Referencing major accomplishments such as Columbian Exchange validates this viewpoint because significance and global impact. Columbus' discovery is the foundation that leads to the development of modern societies.
