1. How did the bombing attack the ideas of American capitalism and government?
2. Who was the attorney general at the time of the bombing? (1 Sentence)
3. Answer A, B, & C (SAQ Format):
  - a. Explain ONE specific piece of evidence that the United States economy had benefited from World War I.
  - b. Briefly explain how World War I created economic and political divisions in the United States.
  - c. Explain one Specific Cause of the limiting of civil liberties as a result of World War I.
4. Answer A, B, & C:
  - a. Briefly explain how the Russian Revolution influenced one of the following:
    - i. American Politics
    - ii. Labor Unions
  - b. Briefly explain one historical development or event that would influence the Palmer Raids.
  - c. Briefly explain how the events immediately following World War I (1919-1920) represented either a community or change in how the government handled labor unions or immigrants in the United States compared to earlier points in American history.

  - a. Briefly explain how A. Mitchell Palmer can be described as a Progressive.
  - b. Briefly explain the event that shifted Palmer's approach to the radical movement and its effects.
  - c. Briefly explain what led to the downfall of A. Mitchell Palmer.
