

#### The Main Idea


• The United State's policy of containment was first put to the test in Korea.

#### World War II



- Japan had controlled Korea during World War II.
- The Soviet Union
   controlled the Northern
   half, and the United
   States the Southern.
- Post WWII, Korea was divided in half.
  - Communist-North
  - Democracy-South

# Korea was divided at the 38<sup>th</sup> Parallel.




# June 1950: The War Begins

The North **Koreans** surprised the world by invading South Korea and quickly controlled much of the South.




#### THE KOREAN WAR IN FOUR MAPS




# The United Nations Responds


- The UN formed after World War II.

  - Domino Theory.






# Military Action

- With primary
   support of the US
   military, the UN
   came to the defense
   of South Korea.
- Truman will eventually FIRE MacArthur

# Pushing North Korea Back

The UN forces over time push the North Korean forces back to within miles of the Korea China boarder.

#### China Attacks

- The Chinese
   come to the aid of
   the North
   Koreans and
   attack UN Forces.
- They push UN forces back to the 38<sup>th</sup> Parallel.



#### Stalemate & Armistice

- For two years, the sides fought to a stalemate.
- Negotiations for an armistice continued for those two years.
- Finally in July 1953, the armistice was signed.

#### The DMZ

- The Demilitarized Zone
- The boarder between the two where military presence is very strong.
- There has never been a peace agreement between the two countries and the threat of violence is a fear around the world.
