- Abhor→ To disapprove or reject of something strongly
- Boorish→ Rough or ill-mannered; somebody who behaves in an insensitive way
- Cynical→ Doubting human nature or the motives of others and the goodness and sincerity of society
- Epistle→ A long formal letter, often intended to provide instruction
- Hamper→To restrict the free movement or progress of someone or something.
- Hersey→ Belief or opinion contrary to what is generally accepted
- Kindle→To help start, ignite something; sometimes referenced to fire
- Noxious → Harmful to life or health, especially by being poisonous
- Obscure → Difficult to understand because of not being fully or clearly expressed
- Respite A brief period of rest and recovery between periods of exertion or after something disagreeable
