3. How should household duties be divided between men and women? Why?

4. Having children is a big decision. If a couple brings a child into this world, what should they be expected to pay for aside from general common sense care? For example should a parent have to pay for a child's college education? A car when they turn 16? Their wedding? What else?

5. Should couples sign a pre-nup before they get married to make getting a divorce easier and less messy?

6. At what age do you think people should start dating and why?

7. At what age should children be left home alone? For a weekend?

8. Do you think that couples should live together before they get married?

9. In terms of dating, is it ok for a senior boy to date a freshmen girl? Why?

10. In terms of dating, is it ok for a senior girl to date a freshmen boy? Why?

11. It is true that 50% of marriages end in divorce but it doesn't affect everyone equally. What do you think leads to more or less of a chance to get divorced?
